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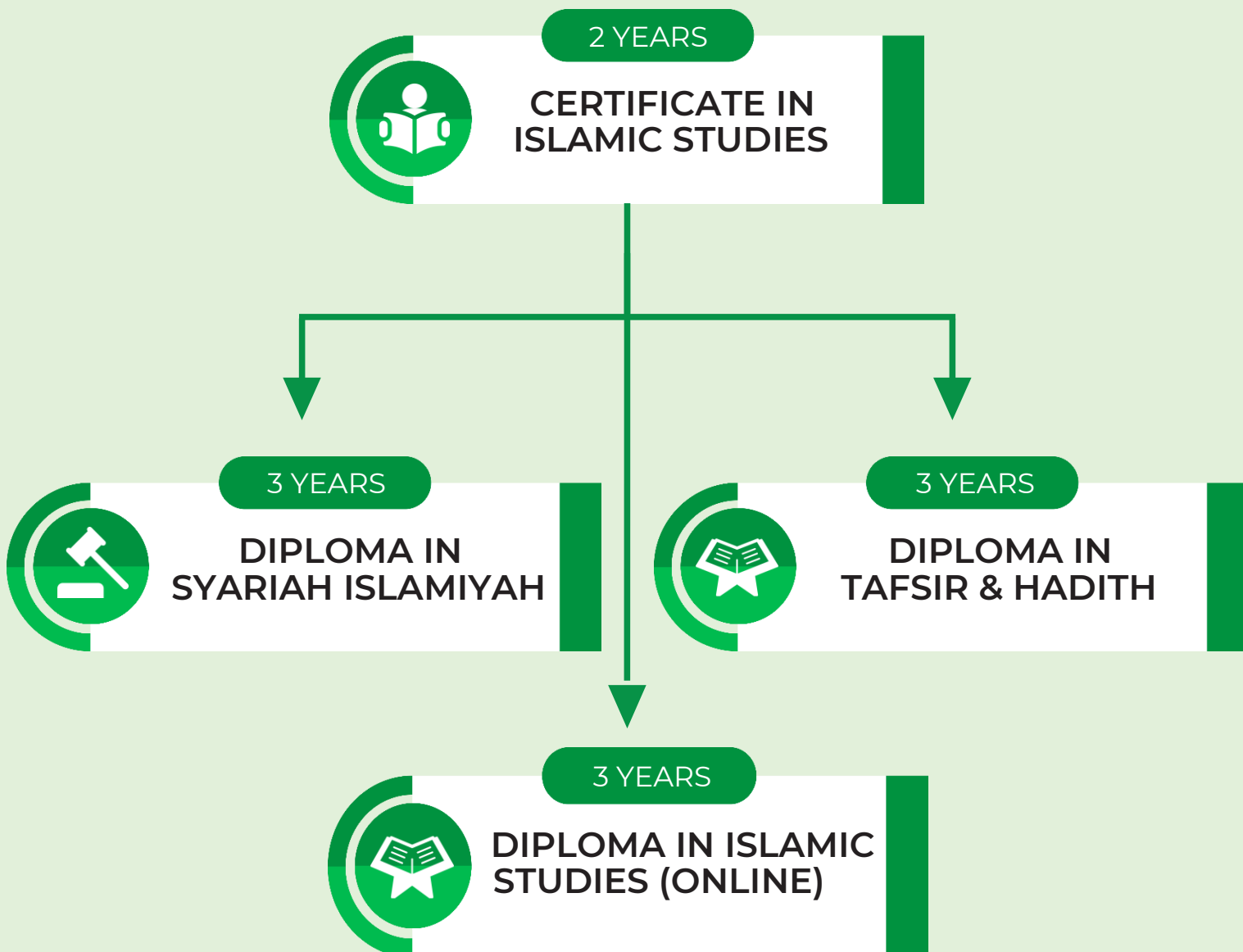

INTRODUCTION

To inculcate a continuous learning culture, Muhammadiyah Islamic College (MIC) designed a structured curriculum in the form of certificate in Islamic studies which is ideal for students who have been studying Fardhu 'Ain at mosques at an introductory level. This programme is modelled with proper syllabus and students will be assessed via presentations, project papers and examinations. At MIC, we believe every Muslim deserved the chance to learn Islam in depth. Hence it is structured in a manner where students will be able to pursue up to degree level.

MIC has identified the combination of Usul Ad-Din, Syariah, Qur'anic and Hadith studies as core subjects in learning and understanding Islam. Thus, at this level, the programmes will focus on the aforementioned subjects in addition to Seerah and Akhlaq.

OBJECTIVE

- Produce Muslim individuals who understand the religion and practice upon it in accordance with the current context of life in Singapore.
- Provide students with fundamental knowledge in Fardhu 'Ain and Islamic Sciences.

CERTIFICATION

Students must complete and pass all **16 credit hours** by which a certificate in Islamic studies will be granted.

ENTRY REQUIREMENT

- Muslim, 16 years old and above
- Able to recognize the Arabic letters

ASSESSMENT METHOD

Each subject will be assessed by examination (60%) and by a continuous assessment (20%) throughout the semester, by means of assignments, presentations, or class tests which will be determined by the lecturer. Students must attend all the weeks of the classes to qualify for attendance marks (20%).

LECTURE SCHEDULE

The curriculum is taught over 4 semesters for 2 years, 4 credit hours for each semester.

REPEAT POLICY

- Students who fail the particular subject will be allowed for a retake examination by which the highest attainable grade is C. Students who fail in the retake must remodel the subject(s) once available..
- No provision of supplementary class unless enough student register for a particular subject. Hence, students will have to wait for the next available class.

1. ISLAMIC CREED

(AQEEDAH ISLAM)



ISLAMIC CREED (2 CREDIT HOURS)

This subject will give an introduction and preface to the knowledge of Aqeedah and will touch on the topics related to the *Makrifat* to Allah and its attributes, the affairs of the prophets, the signs of Judgment Day and others.

The purpose of this subject is to clarify the Islamic creed and connection with faith in God, angels, and other pillars of faith. With this, students can add the spirit of love to God and glorify His greatness, realise the greatness of His creations, and accept the fate and His provisions which sometimes are not known wisdom-on the contrary. Finally, the nature of satisfaction (*redha*) and the nature of *muraqabatullah* can be sown in the hearts of students.

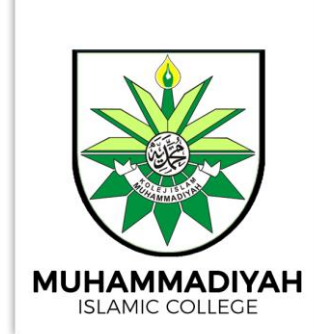

(TAFSIR AL-QUR'AN)



QUR'ANIC EXEGESIS (2 CREDIT HOURS)

This subject explains the purposes, laws, stories and lessons from chosen Surahs. The study will touch on Makkiyyah and Madaniyyah verses where each Surah has a particular approach in explaining the law.

6. PROPHETIC TRADITION

(HADITH NABAWI)



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PROPHETIC TRADITION (2 CREDIT HOURS)

This subject describes the hadith that touch on chapters related to sincerity, repentance, patience, rushing to goodness, etc. These hadith touch on the aspect of building the identity and attitude of a Muslim. All this lead to the formation of the essential Muslim personality shown by Prophet Muhammad.

The purpose of this subject is to assist students of basic and fundamental matters in Islam by studying the 40 Hadiths collected by Imam Nawawi. In addition to encourage students to directly communicate with the Sunnah of the Prophet, through the study of the Hadith. Students are expected to realise the responsibility of a Muslim and appreciate and cultivate the noble teachings learnt from the hadith in their daily lives.

8. QUR'AN & TAJWEED



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QUR'AN & TAJWID (2 CREDIT HOURS)

The lesson to be covered includes discussion on Tajweed as a branch of knowledge and debates related to it such as the description of Makhraj and the characteristics of the letters, the law of Nun Sakinah, Mim Sakinah, Madd, etc. The practical analogy will also be concentrated during the course of study.

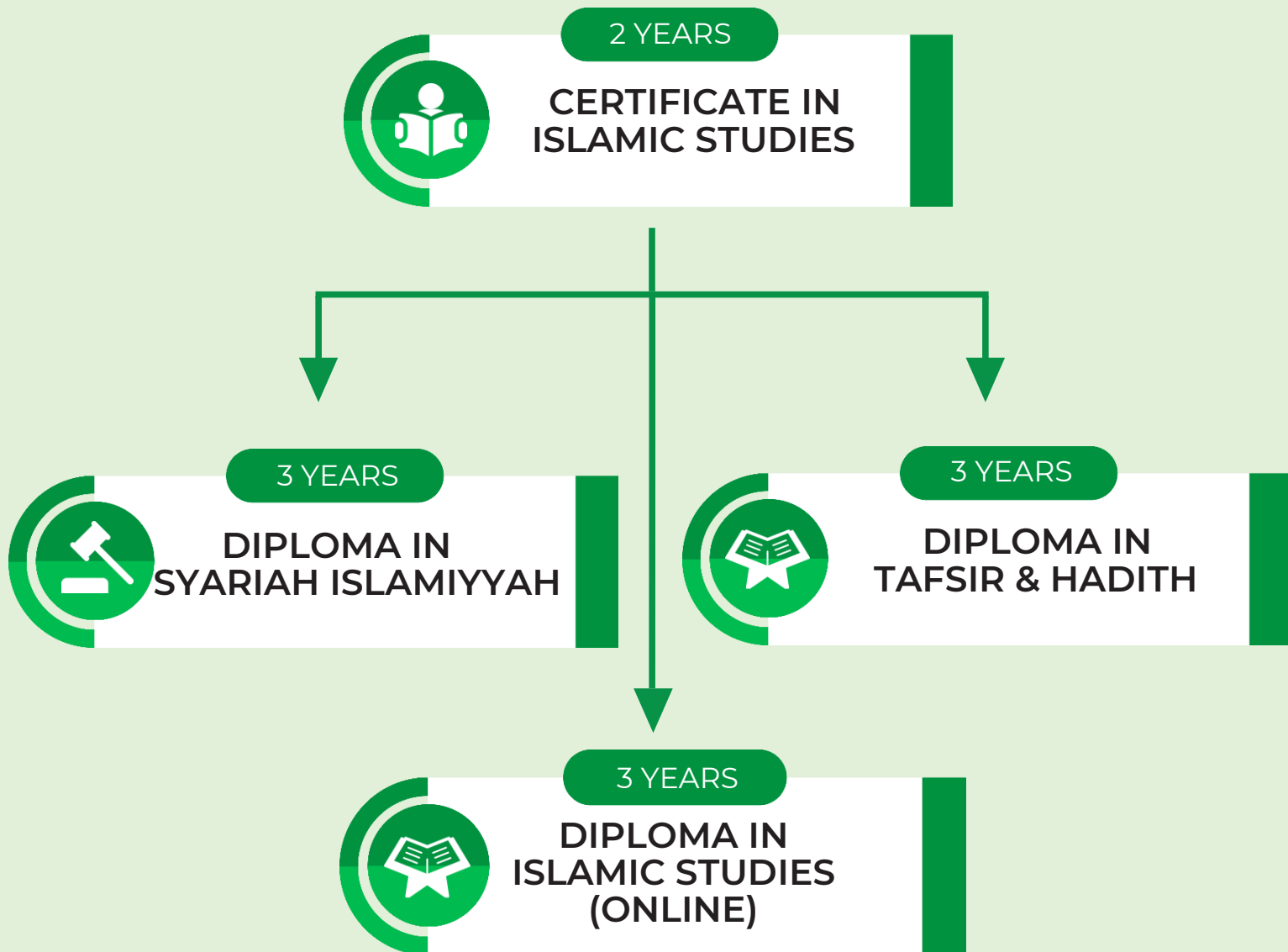
DIPLOMA IN ISLAMIC STUDIES



ACADEMIC PATHWAY



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INTRODUCTION

This course aims at providing exposure to the Islamic worldview, knowledge and perspectives. It is designed to cater for people from all backgrounds and begins with the fundamental teachings of Islam and gradually builds upon this knowledge to present the rich intellectual heritage of Islam and discusses the Islamic solutions to modern problems faced by the Muslim community. The objectives of the course are as follows:

- To enhance the understanding of the Qur'an and the Sunnah
- To develop good morals and Islamic intellectuality based upon the concept of Taqwa (piety)
- To study, understand and find Islamic solutions for contemporary issues

OBJECTIVE

- Produce Muslim individuals who understand the religion and practice it in accordance with the current context of life in Singapore.
- Provide students with fundamental knowledge in Far- du 'Ain and Islamic sciences.

CERTIFICATION

Students must complete and pass all **48 credit hours** by which **28 credit hours of common subjects** and **20 credit hours of core subjects** by which a diploma in Syariah Islamiah or Tafsir & Hadith will be granted.

LECTURE SCHEDULE

The curriculum is taught over 6 semesters for 3 years. 8 credit hours for every semester.

ENTRY REQUIREMENT

- 17 years and above.
- Direct entry
 - a. MIC certificate in Islamic studies holder with the passing grade of B or CGPA 3.00 and above.
 - b. Full-time madrasah student who graduated from secondary 4.
- A relevant certificate with good grades (equivalent to MIC's grade of B or CGPA 3.00) from any other institutions of higher learning recognized by MIC or other relevant professional qualification and experience that are recognized by MIC.
- Applicant may require to satisfy additional requirements such as an entrance test and an interview.

ASSESSMENT METHOD

Each subject will be assessed by examination (60%) and by a continuous assessment (30%) throughout the semester, by means of assignments, presentations, or class tests which will be determined by the lecturer. Students must attend all the weeks of the classes to qualify for attendance marks (10%).

REPEAT POLICY

- Students who fail a particular subject will be allowed for a resit examination by which the highest attainable grade is C. Students who fail in the re-sit must retake the subject(s) in the next semester.
- No provision of supplementary class unless sufficient number of students register for a particular subject. Hence, students will have to wait for the next available class.

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TAFSIR & HADITH

INTRODUCTION

Diploma in Tafsir & Hadith is designed to equip students with fundamental knowledge in the major courses of Tafsir and Hadith, generally applied in Islamic disciplines.

This diploma explores the unique style and arrangement of the Qur'an and the various ways in which people have tried to understand the meanings of the Qur'an. The Qur'an is unlike any other book. It is in this world but does not belong here. It is the eternal word of Allah, The Most High. Not realising this many people approach the Qur'an as they would approach any other book and this often leads to confusion and disappointment. This course will address the principles surrounding understanding, interpreting and reflecting upon the Qur'an.

In perspective of Hadith, it aims to introduce students to different aspects of Hadith sciences. It will explain the methodology used by traditionalists to authenticate Ahadith, the practice of Hadith study, travelling for Hadith, taking notes, reading and hearing and the compilation of Hadith compendia, adducing and juxtaposing Hadith texts to inform understanding of the religion as practice (norms and laws), the increasing sophistication of Hadith criticism and the gradual predominance of Hadith texts as a record of the prophetic Sunnah.

OBJECTIVE

- Develop knowledgeable students on basic principles that cover aspects of Tawhid, Fiqh, Mu'amalat and various Islamic learning perspectives.

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ARABIC LANGUAGE I - II (2 CREDIT HOURS EACH)

Students will learn the essential topics in Arabic grammar so as to equip them for reading Arabic texts in Islamic studies references. Additionally, the focus is on the practical aspect as well. As for Sarf (morphology), the objective is to apply it in writing, reading and understanding Arabic text. In addition to Tasrif (changes), this subject will introduce students to the meanings and implications of Wazan (pattern/form) and how it can affect Arabic sentences.

ARABIC LANGUAGE III (2 CREDIT HOURS)

This subject will be divided to two parts; Adab and Balaghah. Here student will study another variety of the Arabic language which is classical Arabic (CA). Classical Arabic refers to the Arabic language known from the earliest the pre-Islamic era. It comprises of various literary text from prose to poetry form of Arabic. Students will be exposed to rich Arabic literary such as sermons (Khutbah), parables and quotes.

Balaghah on the other hand, is the discipline or tools in understanding the literary text (Adab). Students will uncover Arabic structures and styles in a different dimension where a structure can be interpreted in many aspects such as literal and metaphorical.

This subject focuses on the importance of Hadith verification through the meticulous lenses of Takhrij scholars. It also exposes the participants to the scrupulous classical methodology of Hadith extraction from its inception and witness its evolution from the usage of physical books to digital databases in the pursuit of Sunnah protection and verification.

Students will also be guided on the methods of identifying authentic Hadith through the textual readings of Hadith extractions and in the process learn and discover reliable digital programs, websites and tools to discern Hadith authentication.

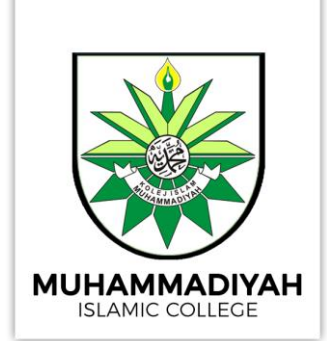

The main topics included in the subject are methodologies of interpretation employed by various exegetes (Mufasssirin), history of the emergence of the Qur'anic interpretation and its stages of development, analysis of the contributions of the Prophet, companions and the successors towards interpretation of the Qur'an, emergence of schools of Tafsir in early periods; classification of Tafsir works; and methodology of those categories of interpretation of the Qur'an focusing on the commendable works (based on traditions, sound reasoning, linguistic and juristic interpretations) and the condemnable works (based on deviationist ideas such as the interpretation by the deviating sects and by unsound reasoning).

The purpose of this subject is to acquaint students with the legacy of Tafsir and the contributions of the earlier as well as later scholars, comprehend most important methods to interpret the Qur'an as well as to enable them to apply sound methodology of Tafsir in resolving contemporary problems.

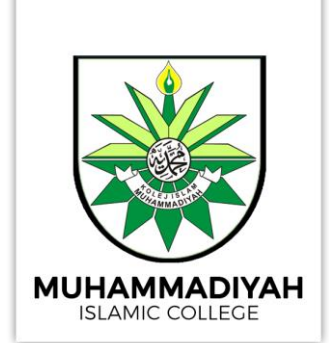
